

Transition Facilitator/Assistant Triage Specialist -Based in Tulsa and Norman, Oklahoma

Provides targeted support services to a SOC that is Young Adults in Transition-centered, with the needs of the young adult and family dictating the types and mix of services provided. Recognize the many barriers consumers and families face when transitioning. Also identifies social, economic, employment, and housing barriers, and identify varied levels of need to overcome these barriers. Develops cooperative working relationships with all agencies serving young adults in transition, from which a consumer might expect to receive direct or indirect services, as well as establishing and maintaining a therapeutic relationship with those consumers and their families who are in need of support.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Meets quality management requirements
- Assists in the development and implementation of programmatic goals and objectives
- Attends staff meetings, workshops, and seminars to learn agency policy, rules, regulations and procedures
- Works with Young Adults in Transition in their homes and communities, and attempt to incorporate the entire family in the treatment program and while remaining focused on the strengths as well as the Young Adults in Transition's age and cultural.
