



What is needed to complete a SAIL referral?

Mental health providers should include the following information hen making a referral to long-term support services:

- SAIL rejental which can be obtained by downloading it at

Psychiatric / psychological evaluation completed within 1 year of the referral date

- Updated / current social service data base or psychosocial assessment
- Current hospitalization initial assessment if applicable
- Copies of hospital and treatment discharge summaries

- Completed and signed release of information and consent
