 - How well the Transition Specialist functions as a coach
 - Ability of encourage
 - Use of MI principles
 - How much does the young adult feels that s/he is participating in planning
 - Quality of the planning

 - o Youth Participation in Planning Tool
 - Look to Synthesis for data on the following:
 - **Domain Review Checklist**
 - Strengths
 - Needs
 - Benchmarks
 - **Futures Plan**
